Coming to terms with the Troubles: women in *Lost Lives*

Join us to hear from Gillian Russell (the Gerry Higgins Professor of Irish Studies at the University of Melbourne).

In 1999 a group of journalists, led by David McKittrick, published *Lost Lives*, a book that tells the story of how each one of the approximately 3,700 men, women and children who were victims of the Troubles met their deaths. As the worst period of the Troubles begins to recede into the past, Gillian explores the task of coming to terms with that experience for a Troubles 'generation', including some personal reflection and consideration of the lost lives of women and girls in this astonishing book.
