



# Will the Korea crisis spark Nuclear War or Just Peace?

- \* The Doomsday Clock that calculates the likelihood of global destruction due to nuclear war or climate change was set earlier this year at two-and-a-half-minutes to midnight.
- \* It was last set this close to midnight in 1953 at the height of the Cold War. Will events in Korea soon push us even closer to midnight?
- \* What is Australia's role in all of this? What should or could it be?
- \* There is now much talk, in the Christian world and beyond, of shifting our theologies, thinking and political discourse from JUST WAR to JUST PEACE? What does this mean and is it doable?
- \* An historic treaty prohibiting nuclear weapons was recently adopted at the UN. None of the nuclear armed states is willing to sign it. The Australian Government has totally opposed it. What will it take to get Australia to sign and ratify the treaty?
