Anne is an experienced theologian and author who has taught sessionally at ACU and UFT. Her work in eco theology is supported by the Centre for Comparative Literature and Cultural Studies, Monash University. In 2005 Anne published *An Ecological Feminist Reading of the Gospel of Luke: A Gestational Paradigm* (Mellen, 2005) and during 2008 she was a Melbourne College of Divinity research scholar. Anne is also a poet of some note who has had her work published in several journals and in a recent anthology.
